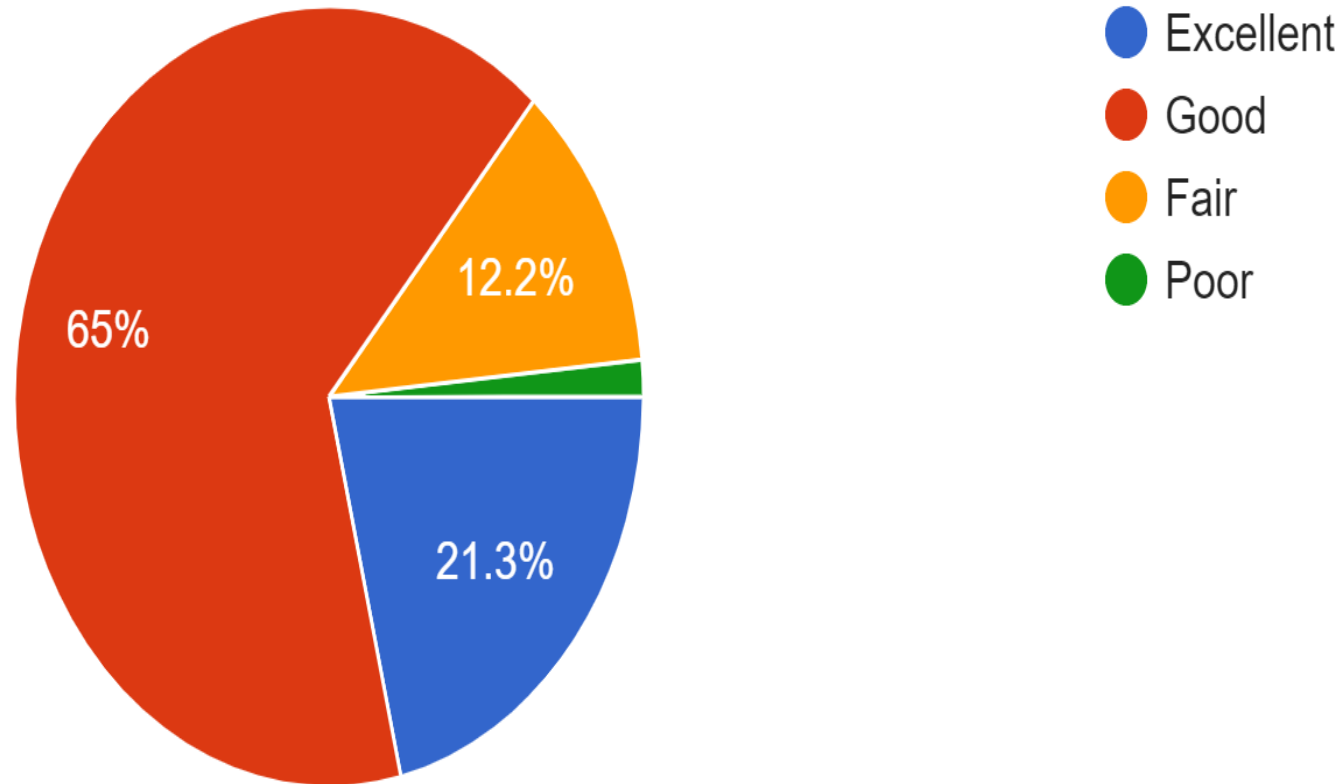

Player Discipline:

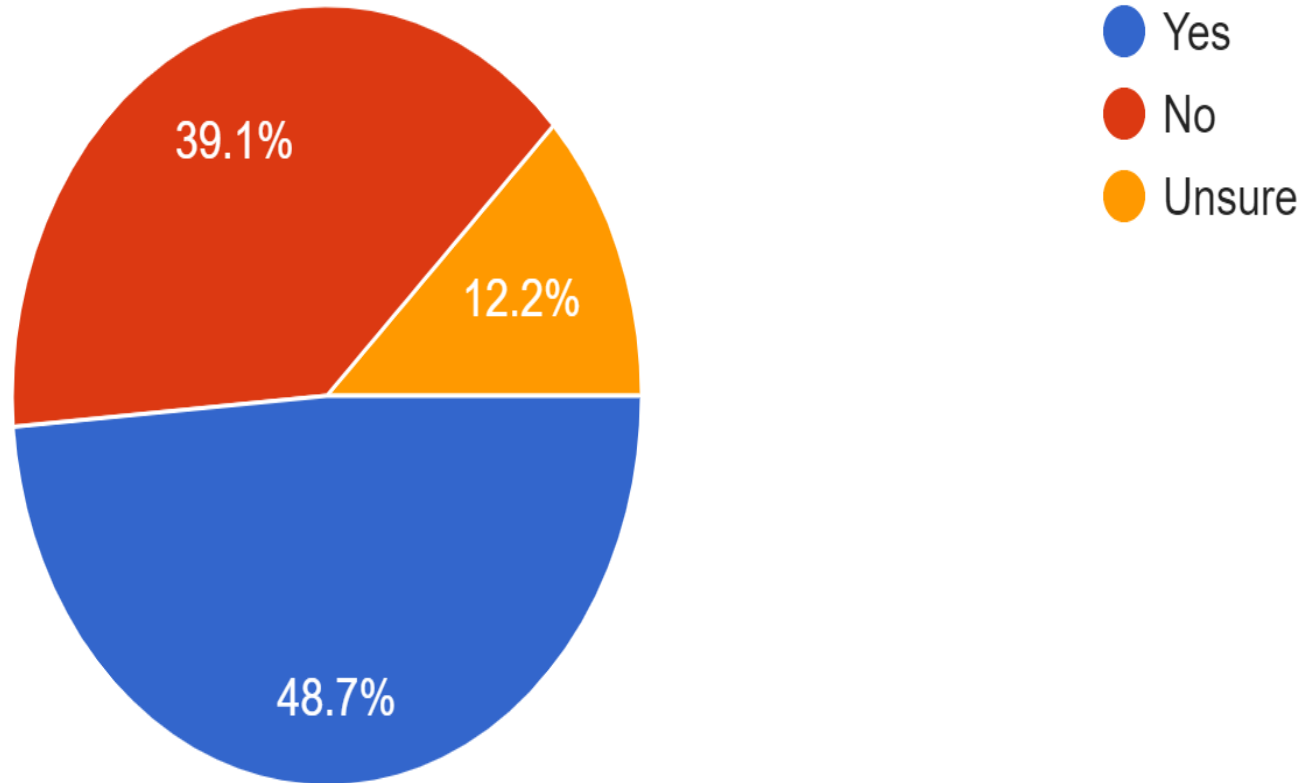
- Overwhelming number of players were happy with discipline levels on the whole

Cricket Teas:

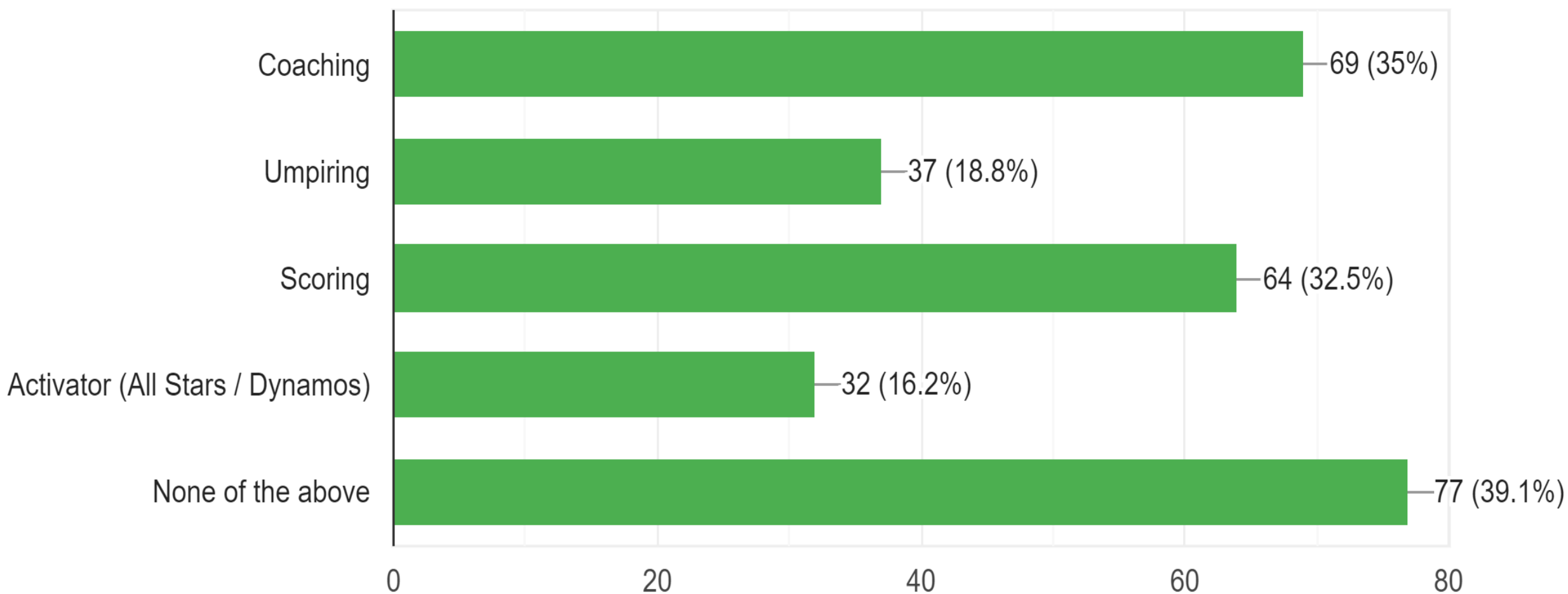
- Again split reasonably evenly
